This term's theme is the important topic of being seen. With the clocks changing and darker evenings, pupils travelling to and from school in dark uniforms are potentially more difficult to see.

Our top tips for Being Bright and Being Seen during the Autumn and Winter...

- **Shop around!** For items with reflective detailing. Many popular brands are now incorporating reflective materials and designs.
- **Fluorescent** colours are better on winter days and **reflective** materials can be seen in car headlights at night.

### More top tips....

- \* *Choose routes and crossing places that are well lit.*
- \* *Cyclists need a clean **red** rear reflector.*
- \* *Working lights (**red** at the back and **white** at the front) are required only when cycling in the dark.*
